GUIDANCE FOR VISITORS TO THE GROUNDS

PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- Visitors to Stirk House Hotel and grounds will be responsible for ensuring that they are **FREE OF COVID-19 SYMPTOMS** or that they have not been in contact with someone who has symptoms or been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to their visit.
- Any person displaying symptoms will not be allowed entry to the estate.
- Any guests who are classed as '**clinically extremely vulnerable**' are at higher risk of infection and **should NOT attend** unless the current guidance regarding this group changes (see link below).
- Any guests who are classed as '**clinically vulnerable**' are at a higher risk of infection and should follow advice – Extra precautions may be appropriate and should be followed if these guests choose to attend.

RISK CONTROL MEASURES

Stirk House will comply with the government's guidance on managing the risk of COVID-19 by following the following 5 steps:

1. **We have carried out a COVID-19 Risk Assessment and shared the results with the people who work here.**
 2. **We have cleaning, handwashing and hygiene procedures in line with the guidance.**
 3. **We have taken all reasonable steps to help people work from home.**
 4. **We have taken all reasonable steps to maintain social distancing in the workplace.**
 5. **Where people cannot be 2m apart we have done everything to manage the transmission risk.**
- Stirk House will limit the number of visitors by using a booking system.
 - Grounds visitors will not have access inside the hotel at the current time, however we will provide toilet facilities outside with handwashing facilities and sanitiser.
 - We will expect all visitors to comply with social distancing and our employees will need to ensure that this is the case.
 - We will not ask visitors to wear face coverings unless government guidance changes, however we do emphasise the need to stay 2m apart wherever possible.
 - All visitors will be required to maintain good respiratory and hand hygiene paying particular attention to government guidance of frequent handwashing and using and disposing of tissues.
 - We will require details of each visitor for the government's Test and Trace system.
